Key issues that need to be addressed

Acumen has been involved in a plethora of redelivery projects, representing lessors as well as some operators. This exposure has provided valuable insights, as to the key issues that need to be addressed, and helped identify not only the gap in expectations by each of these parties, but also the challenges they face throughout the process.

These include:

- Lack of knowledge sharing and transfer within and between the teams – Some of the resources allocated by the operators to represent during redeliveries were never trained to manage such responsibilities
- Imbalance in the demand and supply of skilled resources - This resulted in high attrition of key resources amongst the operators. Thus resulting in frequent drain out of skillset within a team. A rigorous training program would assist in managing this unavoidable volatility
- Lack of process standardisation – The sudden spurt of new airlines and huge order books has posed a challenge to focus on building teams with a strong foundation in managing these assets while on lease.

Why India's airlines are so important ?



Evidence shows that air travel has largely recovered, post pandemic and that there is a focus on emerging markets, especially Asia. India, in particular, is one of the fastest growing aviation markets and its domestic air travel makes up for **69% of total air traffic in South Asia**.

This is a cause for optimism, however this growth has highlighted a regional skills gap in terms of qualified and experienced resources with the capability to manage this collective growth.



Our proposal

To produce a customised training program in consultation with lessors and operators. The objective here is to address the gap in the skillset and alleviate the avoidable struggle between the stakeholders.

We will:

- > Identify the critical areas to be addressed during training. Key take aways from a mixture of current and past project experience between the stakeholders will assist in this.
- > Develop training modules bearing in mind the current and immediate requirement for enhancement of skillset in the team. Training interventions to be planned, taking into the time sensitivities regarding airline operations. Courses will be short and carried out at regular intervals during the year.
- > Design course material to aid ease of reference and application beyond these training programs.
- > A channel to be established for addressing any key concerns pertaining to aircraft lease management.
